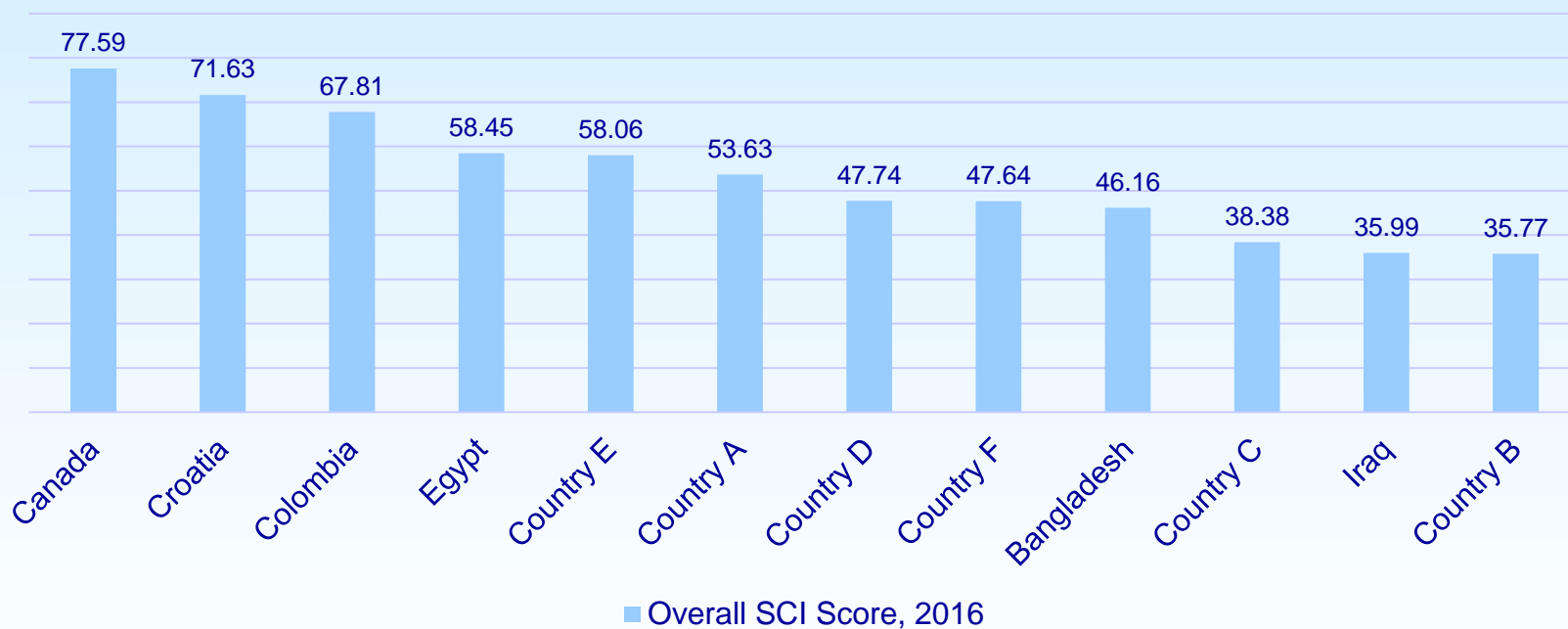
GCC Countries...

- Share common economic, social, cultural and religious characteristics and face similar challenges:
 - High income countries,
 - Relatively small population,
 - Heavily natural resource dependent economies,
- Have undertaken important political, administrative and fiscal reforms,
- Developed their National Vision documents that provide a roadmap for the country's development and economic objectives.

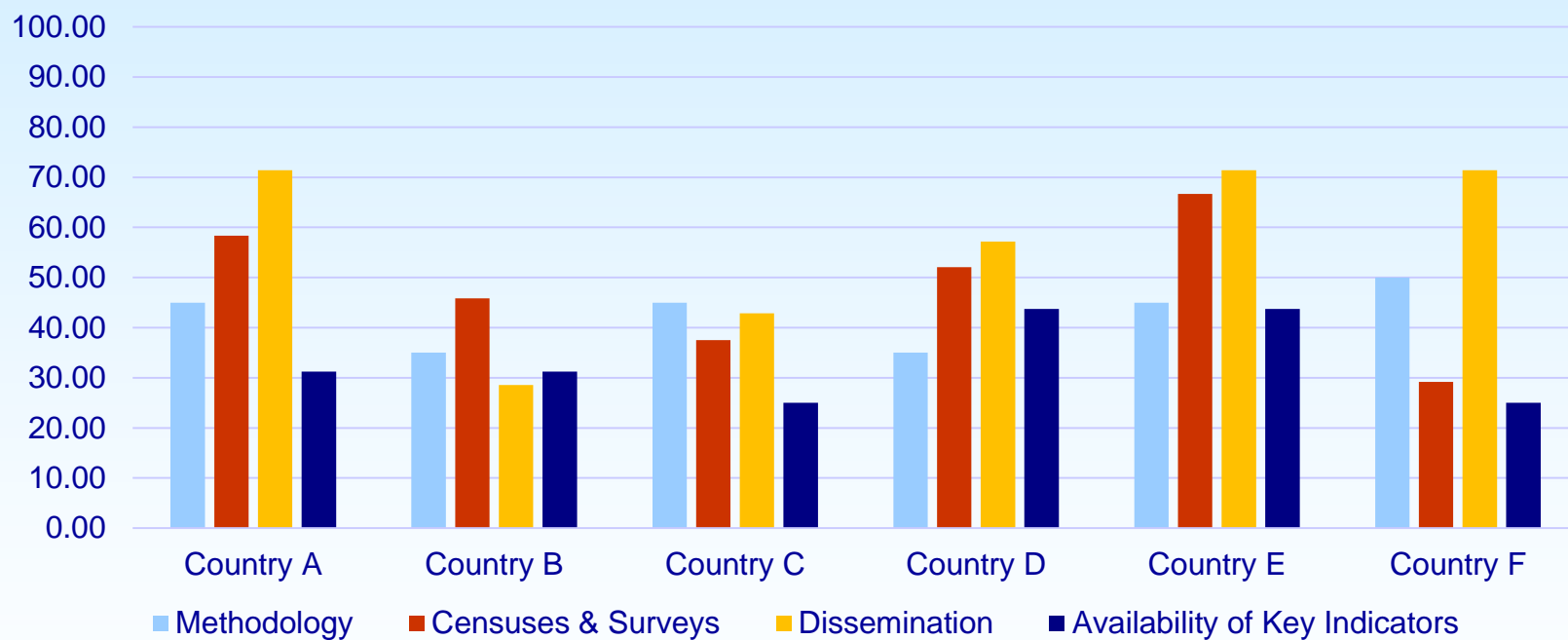
National Vision and requirements

- *Diversify the economy and improve its competitiveness that will help reduce oil dependency*
- Development and successful implementation of the Vision programs is an information intensive process.
- Requires a well-functioning national statistical system that could produce and disseminate relevant, reliable statistical data in a timely manner
- A robust national statistical system can greatly improve the quality of policymaking and reduce inefficiencies,

SCI Score of GCC countries

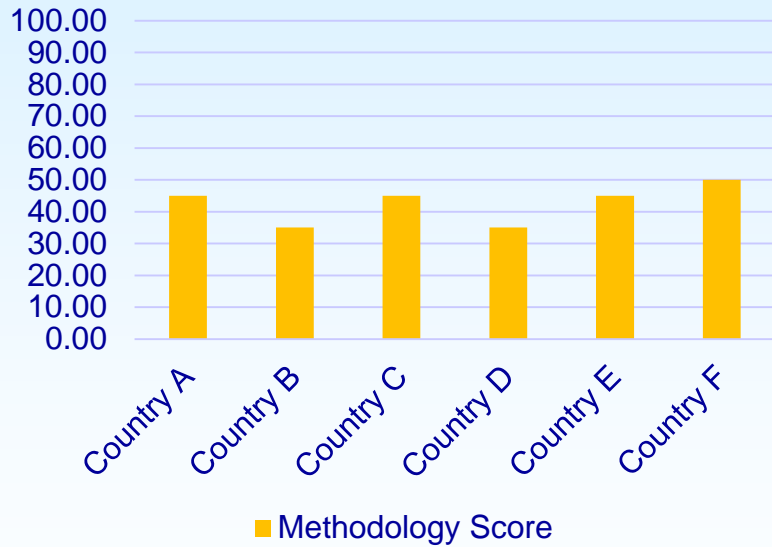


SCI Score Breakdown of GCC countries

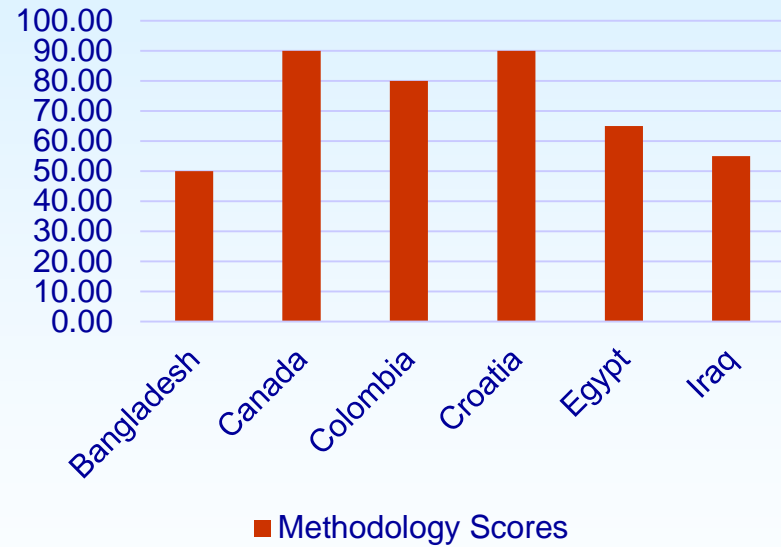

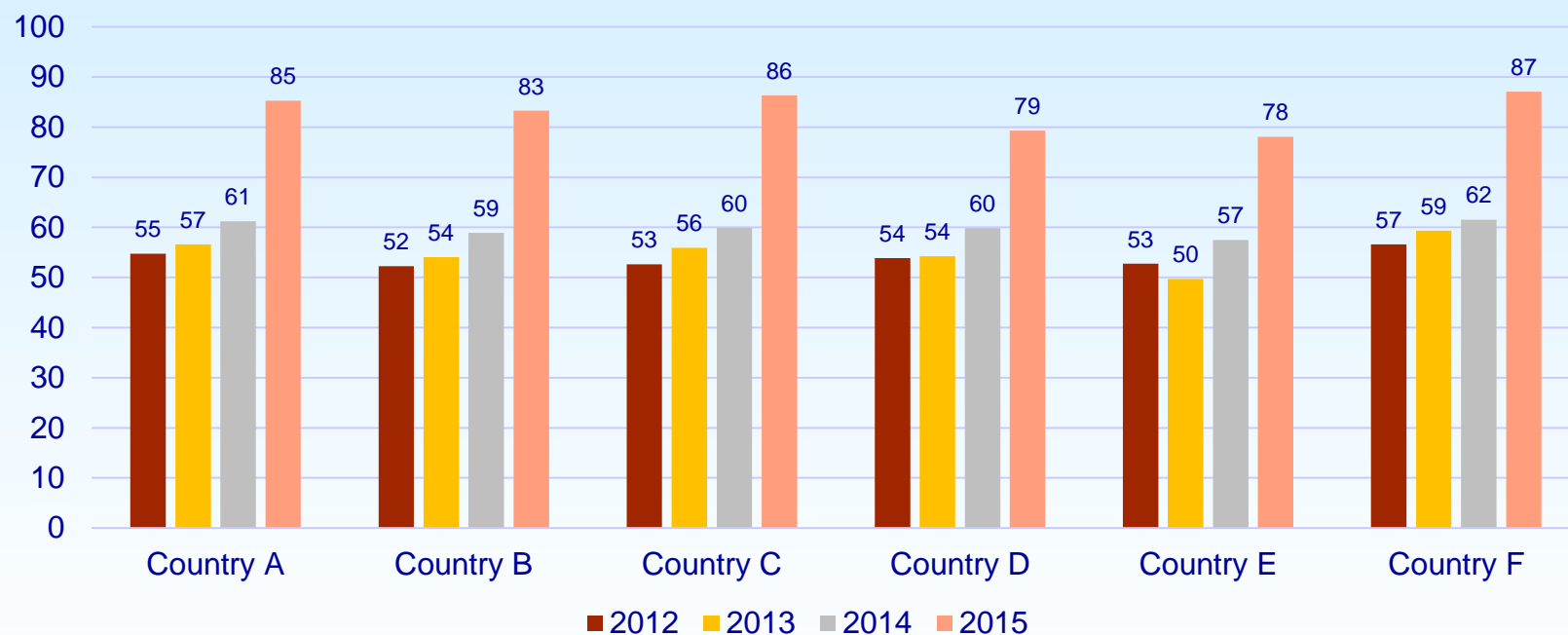

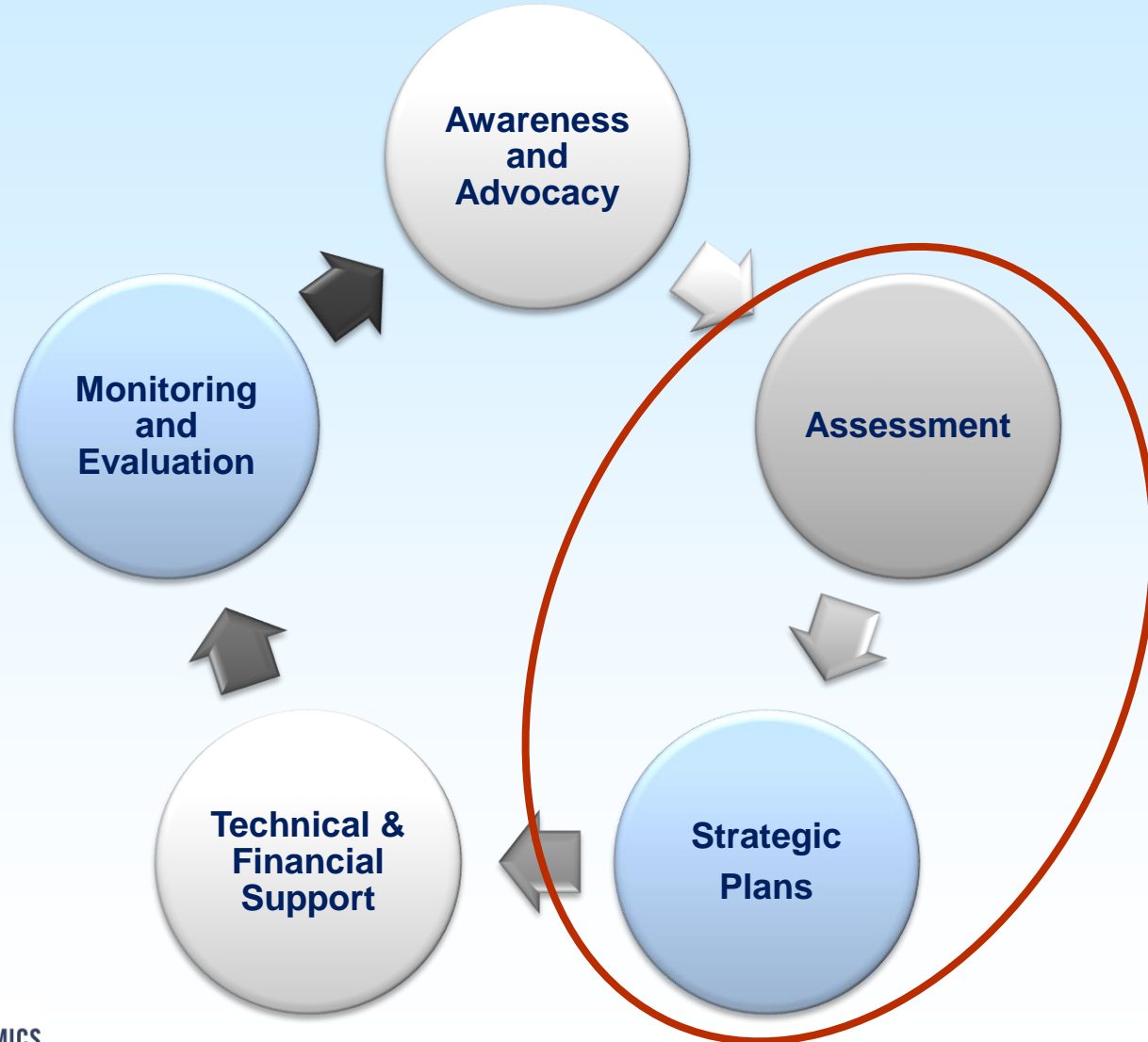
Comparison Countries

Closing gaps in specific statistical areas (vertical)

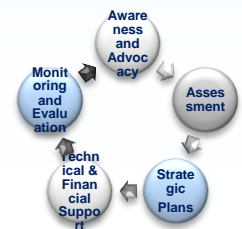


What might need improving?

- Institutional and organizational architecture of the system to make it more effective,
- Coordination role of the statistical office,
- User and respondent relations,
- Data sharing frameworks and arrangements
- Application of internationally accepted concepts and methods
- HR policy and staff skills
- IT infrastructure
- New or existing data production processes (data capture, data validation, dissemination)

Next Steps

- Identify outputs (indicators, products and services) linked to key development priorities
- Identify opportunities to improve efficiency and effectiveness of production, dissemination, and use of data
- Link these activities to internationally accepted standards, methods, practices, and tools.

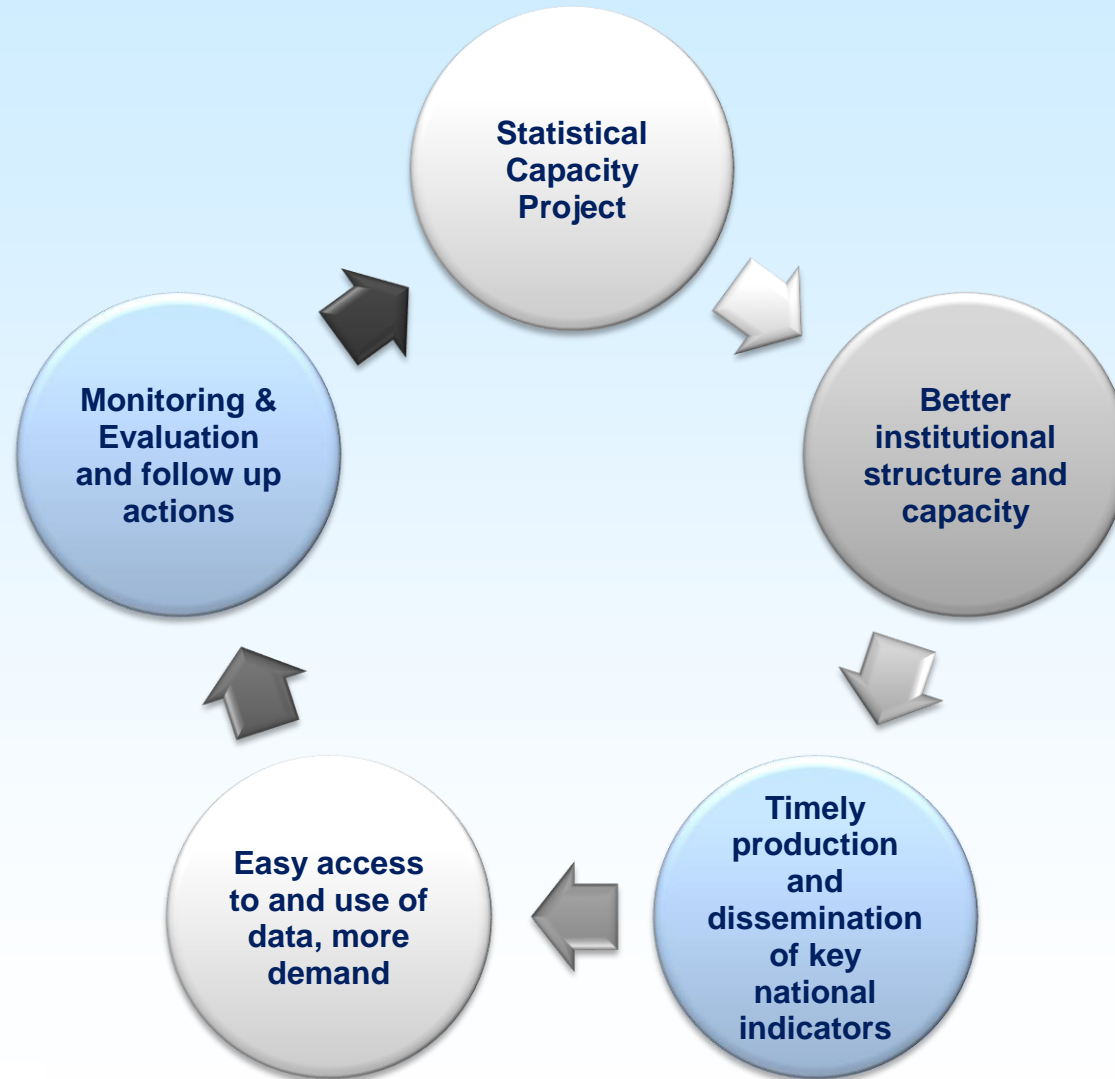


How to improve?
