






Mobile phone network data for population statistics (Belgium)


Census (2011)


Mobile phones (2015)






Mapping to a regular grid








Correlation between Census data and mobile network data






Present population at 00:00






Present population at 12:00






Mobile phone network data for automatic classification of territory




