


16.1.1 Number of victims of intentional homicide per

100,000 population

Overall, male victims represent 89.5% of all homicide victims; specially those between 15 and 44 years old (72.7%).








16.1.3 Proportion of population subjected to physical, psychological or sexual violence in the previous 12 months

On average, 2% of the population (aged 18 and over) have experienced physical or any other type of violence during the criminal event.




16.1.4 Proportion of population that feel safe walking alone around the area they live

In general, men walk around the area they live at night more consistently than women. Age does not reflect substantial differences.



16.2.1 Proportion of children aged 1-17 years who experienced any physical punishment and/or psychological aggression by caregivers in the past month


Percentage of children aged 12-17 whose parents or tutors have...




16.2.2 Number of victims of human trafficking per 100,000 population

Proxy

Since 2011, there are 2,496 **recorded (detected)** victims of human trafficking; that is a rate of 1 victim per 100,000 population (total)



16.2.3 Proportion of young women and men aged 18-29 years who experienced sexual violence by age 18




16.3.1 Proportion of victims of violence in the previous 12 months who reported their victimization to competent authorities or other officially recognized conflict resolution mechanisms


On average, only 12% of victims of violence report their victimization to law



16.3.2 Unsentenced detainees as a proportion of overall prison population


On average, the rate of unsentenced detainees for common crime law is 37%; in turn, the rate of unsentenced detainees for federal crime law is 46%.





Corruption experiences when making payments, formalities and public services requests (PFS)




16.6.2 Proportion of the population satisfied with their **last** experience of public services




16.7.1 Proportion of positions in public institutions compared to national distribution

Distribution by age (State level)




Distribution by sex (State level)


