

- Article 5.3: Gather and analyze data with the cooperation of other governmental entities (Partnership).



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The roles of the DSCD:


- 1. To collect **quality**, disaggregated information in respect to development goals;
- 2. To establish current levels, disparities and future projections (trends);
- 3. To analyse the data using causality analysis;
- 4. To establish a valid Community Development Strategy;
- 5. Monitoring, evaluation, and impact assessment.



Data Collection, Utilization and Strategizing

- Data collection, tabulation and release.
- Census, sample surveys, administrative records & [big data].
- Population, socioeconomic, demographic, housing, environmental and community data.
- Individual, household, family, group and community level.


